Wisconsin Head Start Association block guest rooms are available at the single occupancy rate of \$70 * or the double and triple occupancy rate of \$119. A deposit of the first night plus tax** is due at the time the reservation is made.

Accommodations include either one King bed or two Queen beds based upon the number of guests sharing the room to a maximum of four people. Rooms with one King bed and a sofa bed have a base price for two people in the room. Rooms with two Queen beds may also be available with a sofa bed and have a base price for four people in the room. When adding an additional guest to the rooms with sofa beds there will be a charge of \$20 per person per night in addition to the base price.

Each guest room includes a hair dryer, coffee maker, microwave, refrigerator, iron, ironing board, 27" TV, alarm clock, voice mail, internet access port, and a water park wristband for each *registered guest*.

To assure availability, reservations must be made by Friday, January 13, 2012.

After the cut-off date the hotel will release unreserved rooms in the group block, however the Kalahari will still honor the WHSA room rate until all rooms are full.

The Kalahari cancellation policy for individual reservations guaranteed with a deposit, purchase order or authorizing letter requires at least 72 hours notice prior to arrival to receive refund (the deposit excluding a \$25 processing fee); notice less than 72 hours prior to scheduled arrival forfeits entire deposit.

*A \$119 guest room rate will be applied at the time reservations are made and will be adjusted to the \$70 or prevailing State rate for single occupancy once validated at check-in.

**You must present a tax exemption ID card, government letter stating you are traveling on state business, or pay with a government credit card in order to receive tax exemption status.
